

# Mad River Youth Soccer League (MRYSL) Financial Assistance Guidelines 2012

## Mad River United Program (D-1/D-3)

- ☆ Financial assistance of up to \$200 will be awarded upon approval.
- ☆ The financial assistance will **assist** in covering league registration fees. The monies will be transferred from the league account to the individual team's account. **The remainder of registration fees and any team fees is still the responsibility of the player's family.** Fundraising can be done to raise additional fees.
- ☆ Each applicant is required to complete a financial assistance application form and provide information as to their financial need. Financial support provided by each parent, even if not living in the same household, is required.
- ☆ Each family/player awarded financial assistance will be required to volunteer a minimum of ten (10) hours at league organized fundraising events (tournaments, concessions, jamboree, etc.), in addition to any team related fundraising activities.
- ☆ Financial assistance funds requested for an additional season in the same calendar year to be approved by financial assistance committee and will also be based upon availability of remaining funds in financial assistance account.
- ☆ The financial assistance selection committee is selected by the Board of Directors and will review the applications in a timely fashion.
- ☆ The financial assistance form should be completed and submitted to the league based upon the following deadlines:
